The ancient Irish process for the inauguration of a chief requires that it is held in a remarkable place that overlooks the territory. The map below shows the location of the hedge school which is situated between Dolla and Kilcommon in Tipperary. It is on an elevated site overlooking Windygap.

# MALE KENNEDY FIRST NAMES

We have now completed the listing of the major Kennedy first names listed in the baptism registers for the parishes of Kilcommon, Kilmore, Newport, Templederry and Upperchurch. It now remains for us to list the less common first names for these parishes.

Names such as Darby and Derby appeared relatively early in the registers but did not endure. We have previously indicated that Matheson provided a reference in 1901 that indicated that Irish equivalents for English names included "Jeremiah or Darby, Dermot, Diarmid, Diarmud".

Other uncommon names seem to be confined to particular areas or families. This could be an indication that they entered the family through the mother's side. The name Bartholomew, abbreviated as Bat, Bart or Bartholw, was given to the second son of Patrick Kennedy of Toureenbrien who was born in 1771. He appears to have been named after his mother's father. More research would be needed to confirm this assumption.


