
## **KENNEDY HERITAGE GROUP MEMBERSHIP**

#### A COMMUNICATION FROM JIM RYAN

My name is James (Jim) Ryan from Melbourne and last week I received my order for the following three books: The Irish Kennedys, The Upper Ormond Kennedys & The Mountainy Kennedys Volume 2. Firstly thank you for the magnificent job that Brian Kennedy and many others have done in compiling these fascinating insights into Irish history and more particularly that of the Kennedys of Tipperary.

As my name would suggest I am descended from Ryans from Tipperary (and Limerick) and I have encountered the dual frustrations of the limitations of Irish records as well as trying to trace the surname Ryan from this region.

In view of this, I recently had my DNA tested and arranged the same for my mother (my father died several years ago). From these results, I have many Kennedy DNA matches on both my maternal and paternal lines. My four closest Ryan matches all come from the parish of Newport, so it is unsurprising that I have several Kennedy matches and I am eager to explore these connections.

Someone recently sent a copy of Monsignor Roger Kennedy's book, which contained many clues and compelled me to purchase the above three books to further my research.

On page 305 of 'the Mountainy Kennedys Volume 2', under the heading of Kilcommon, you have detailed the research of a Gail from Victoria, who has traced her line of Kennedys that includes Mary Kennedy (daughter of John Kennedy & Bridget Carey), who married John Stapleton in Ballarat and who died in Camperdown in 1916. One of my DNA matches is with this Mary Kennedy, so I would be interested in getting in contact with Gail. I am unsure whether you are able to provide people's email address. If not, I am happy for you to forward this email to Gail and for her to contact me.

In closing I think that it is great to see the level of enthusiasm for this type of research and the willingness of people to share their information. I am sure that Monsignor Kennedy and his father and grandfather would be thrilled that their passion for family history has continued to grow thanks to the dedication of the generations that have followed them. What a wonderful legacy.

#### Hello Jim.

Thanks for your enquiry. Firstly, let me apologise for the late response. Sean is overseas at present and I have only just received your message.

There is an old saying in Tipperary – "You can't throw a stone around here without hitting a Ryan". You have probably heard it. I have many Ryan relatives there including Donnacha who plays Rugby for Ireland.

I am currently finishing my sixth book on the Kennedys. Someone in Tipperary asked me if I would be writing books about the Ryans. I said they would have to do that for themselves but I would be happy to advise.

I have had a look for Gail's contact details without any luck. I receive a great many contacts and have to reduce the load on my inbox every now and then. I do put out a monthly newsletter and can include your request in that. Perhaps we will get a response.

Monsignor Roger Kennedy is from the same Kennedys as mine. I have visited Knocknamoheragh many times and sat in the kitchen where he wrote his notes on his trips home.

I am glad you are enjoying the books.

#### ...AND AN EXCHANGE OF CORRESPONDENCE WITH PROFESSOR COLLEEN CARTWRIGHT

#### Hi Brian

I recently came across some information from the 1851 England Census that shows that my GG grandfather Thomas Kennedy (b1791) and GGGM Margaret (Regan) Kennedy (b 1806) and lots of their children were living in the Walsall Foreign Parish in Staffordshire England at that time (and it seems, at least from 1843) but they were back again in Toomevara by the time Thomas died in 1864.

Irish research record, Person ID 943168 or 941168 (hard to read) says: Thomas Kennedy of Monanore, Parish/District of Toomevara, Nenagh, Tipperary d 18/5/1864, buried 28/05/1864.

I guess lots of people from Ireland went to England when times were very tough "at home"

Toomevara is in Lower Ormond, isn't it? I'm looking forward to the next book.

#### Hello Colleen,

You are in luck. Toomevara is in Aghnameadle Parish in Upper Ormond. "The Upper Ormond Kennedys – Their Claims to Tipperary Soil" was published last year. As an example, a quick check of the Toomevara Baptisms included in the book reveals Patt, baptised 1834.03.26, son of Tom and Mgt. Kennedy of Blean, witnesses Michael Regan and Mary Cormick. There are others. There is also a listing of Thomas Kennedy of Monanore in the Civil Survey c 1850.

Your Irish Kennedy Heritage Group membership scroll will be in the mail shortly.

I went to the Parish House in Toomevara & "minutely scoured" the Baptism registers. I have all the Baptisms to Tom & Margaret - including one which says Margaret Ryan but I know for sure is Regan, even if Norah O'Meara refuses to accept that.

There is no record in the Toomevara registers for the 4 oldest children but I have since found one of them Baptised in Limerick, so I'm assuming the others might have been too. Possibly Thomas & Margaret lived there for a while before going back to Toomevara.

Hello Colleen.


Your scroll is on the way.

#### THE LOWER ORMOND KENNEDYS






## **BOOKS**
