#### **UPGRADING OF KENNEDY MEMORIALS**


Several Kennedy families have recently been upgrading the memorials to members of their families. Examples from Templederry and Kilkeary cemeteries are shown below.



The Kennedy "Johns" of Foilduff have used an interesting approach to making an old Templederry headstone readable. A modern addition was placed on the old headstone that replicates the weathered inscription to Matthew Kennedy who died in 1788.



The Bunacum and Killeen Kennedys have recently renovated the memorial to their families in the ancient O'Kennedy burial ground of Kilkeary.



Prior to her recent passing it was the wish of Breda Kennedy, mother of Chief Rody Kennedy, that her Kennedys from Hollyhill were recorded on a stone at Kilkeary.
