

IRISH KENNEDY HERITAGE GROUP 7TH ANNUAL GATHERING

The next Irish Kennedy Heritage Group Annual Gathering is planned as follows:

Kennedys and their relatives and friends from Ireland and around the world meet at Chief Rody Kennedys for their seventh annual gathering. All are welcome.

The event will be preceded by a tour of historic Kennedy graveyards at Ballinaclough, Kilkeary and Templederry. Also included is a visited to Cloghenane Castle (Castle Otway) built by David Kennedy. The tour will commence at 2:00 pm at Chief Rody's at Rearcross and return in time for the Gathering. Included in the tour will be the viewing of a Sheela-na-gig. Most of these pre-reformation church fertility figures are now in museums but this one can be seen in-situ.

An audio-visual presentation on Irish Kennedy history will be shown at the Gathering.

Larry's great great grandfather Timothy Kennedy was born in Lismore, Toomevara in 1818. Timothy's son, Jeremiah (on the right above) was born in Lismore in 1848 before Timothy emigrated to the U.S.A. Jeremiah's son, Jeremiah Joseph Kennedy, (on the left above) was born in New York in 1891 and today his grandson Larry Auth is a proud member of the Irish Kennedy Heritage Group.

KENNEDYS IN THE 1835 CENSUS OF NEWPORT AND BIRDHILL

The most Rev. Dr. Slattery, Archbishop of Cashel and Emly, requested the Rev. Edward O'Shaughnessy to undertake a census of the united parishes of Newport and Birdhill in January 1835. Kennedys listed in this census are as follows. (Note the old spelling of Kennedy)
