THE NEXT KENNEDY BOOK

Brian Patrick Kennedy.



Brian's official status according to his Facebook profile is '**RETIRED**' Make up your own mind on reading the following.

While I am waiting for my autobiography to be delivered from the printers I have taken on the big challenge of the next Irish Kennedy book.

The six books so far have covered the history of the Kennedys in Upper and Lower Ormond and adjacent areas in North Tipperary. In addition, the probable movement of JFK's relatives to Wexford has been provided. Many Kennedys have used these books to research their family history with degrees of success.

Quite a few Irish Kennedy descendants from areas outside those covered by the published books have been in touch with me in recent times looking for clues about their ancestors. This is where the research becomes very challenging but also very rewarding. I am now endeavouring to produce a book on "The Other Irish Kennedys". O'Kennedys are recorded in other baronies of Tipperary as well as other counties of Ireland as far back as 1353. The first were light horsemen and foot soldiers who were

mercenaries. In later years they are recorded as kerns, yeomen, swordmen, husbandmen, fishermen, stewards, servants and various other occupations.

The O' indicates that they or their ancestors were originally from North Tipperary. They earlier movers were not landholders at first and were apparently in the employ of others. The transplantation of Kennedys to other counties after the Cromwellian dispossessions in 1656 and 1657 added to their diaspora. By the time of the so called Census of 1659 there were over 300 Kennedy families in 17 counties outside of Tipperary. The research to date has revealed locations and names that can be seen to be associated over several generations. If you have any particular areas and first names outside of North Tipperary that are part of your Kennedy family traditions I would be pleased if you would let me know at mountainykennedys@gmail.com so they can be included in the research.

If the research proceeds as expected I would hope to have the next Kennedy book available for launching at the Kennedy Gathering at Chief Rody Kennedy's at Rearcross, Tipperary, in July next year.

So any Kennedys out there around Ireland who might be able to add to Brian's research please pass it on to the email mentioned in Brian's article.

PROFESSOR MARK KENNEDY.

Mark Kennedy from Geelong, Victoria, Australia has made enormous strides in the last few years in piecing together his own family tree, firstly back to the Garavane, Rearcross, Kennedys and then further back to Long Andrew Kennedy.

Mark has become a regular visitor to Ireland and has decided to concentrate his research into linking different branches of the Kennedy clan through their DNA. At the 2017 Kennedy Clan Mark gave a very informative and interesting presentation on the use of DNA in family research. On his most recent visit in September he took DNA samples from 20 different people of Kennedy Heritage and is now inputting the results as they filter back to him on a dedicated Kennedy family tree

It is a laborious and time consuming task but when complete will hopefully succeed in establishing definite links between the Kennedy diaspora.

John and Katherine have already been to Ireland twice, are planning to come again in 2018 and hoping to publish a scholarly paper and book on their Kennedy Heritage.

Hugh Sweeney lives in Newport, Co. Tipperary and traces his family History to the Kennedys of Glenculloo.

John knows that his great, great grandfather was born in Carrick-on-Suir in 1806 to James and Katherine Kennedy and John's DNA test confirms that he is direct descendant of Brian Boru. He has already visited Ireland and climbed both Tullaun and Lackeen castles and found the old ring fort at Rathurles and hopes to visit again in 2019.

Both John David and John Michael found us on our new website irishkennedyheritagegroup.ie that we hope will continue to be a focal point for Irish Kennedys worldwide.


