

Kennedy Clan Gathering 2018.

Brian has finalised his plans for our **tour of Kennedy Country** on Sunday 8th July

Starting at Chief Rody Kennedy's pub at Rearcross at 1pm sharp as follows:

- Chief Rody's Rearcross to Foilduff. Five Kennedy farms in a row. Johns, Dannys, Drummers, Peelers and Murphys.
- Foilduff to Glenculloo. Original site where the Kennedys from the Silvermines area hid out after Cromwell.
- **Glenculloo to Killoscully** graveyard and pub. Kennedys from Glenculloo, Foilduff, Knockfune, Bunkimalta, Knocknamoheragh, Reabeg, Bealaclave, Toor, Muingacree etc are buried here.
- **Killoscully to Toor** church (built by Kennedys) and pub. Plaque in memory of Dr Henry Kennedy to be unveiled on bridge at 5pm.
- Toor to the Ball Alley near Knocknamoheragh (Building overseen by Fr. Rody Kennedy of Knocknamoheragh). Parking across the road. Excellent view of Keeper and Long Andrew country.
- Knocknamoheragh to Rearcross.
- Further visit to Toureenbrien Upper (Settled by Patrick Kennedy from Templederry area pre 1750. Ancestor of many Kennedys including Knocknamoheragh, Foilduff and Foilycleara). Visit yet to be arranged as key is required to enter.



Looking forward to it already.

After the tour it's back to Chief Rody's for relaxation, refreshment, information and education. Among the night's activities planned are;

- Launch of Brian's latest book "The Dispersal of the Irish Kennedys" across the Irish Republic from North Tipperary official launch by Joe Kennedy, Callan, Co. Kilkenny.
- Presentation by Mark Kennedy on his D.N.A. Research of the Irish Kennedys.
- Performance of Irish Music and Dance by 8 Kennedy cousins from Cappamore, Co. Limerick.
- Informal chat, networking and tracing among the Kennedy Diaspora.
- Recording of programme to be broadcast on Tipp F.M Local Radio.

Then on **Tuesday 10th July** Phyllis Kennedy has organised a **guided tour of Nenagh Castle and the nearby Heritage Centre** where visitors can view The Irish Kennedy Heritage Display.

Tipperary Immigrants in Syracuse, New York State, U.S.A.

The following story was related to me by one of my own ancestors who emigrated from Chalkhill, Templederry, to Syracuse, New York in the 1840's – make up your own mind.

Between the 1820s and 1860's many emigrants from North Tipperary including Kennedys left their homelands and found work in upstate New York. So many of them settled in a hilly part of the city of Syracuse that it became known locally as Tipperary or Tipp Hill.

All was well until the civil authorities installed the first traffic lights (signals) in the city in 1925 at an intersection at the bottom of Tipperary Hill. The traffic lights were promptly vandalised by youths from the Tipperary enclave who objected to seeing the Red (of Britain) over the Green (of Ireland) on the traffic lights. Numerous repairs followed by repeated breaking of the lights ensued until the City authorities relented in 1928 and agreed to install lights at that junction with the green light on top and the red light at the bottom. Hence the upside –down traffic lights in Syracuse.



The Upside- Down Traffic Lights on Tipperary Hill, Syracuse, New York State, U.S.A.


