Then we will repair to the Angelsey Lounge at Chief Rody Kennedy's in Rearcross for chat, tracing and refreshments where Brian Patrick Kennedy's latest book 'The Irish Kennedys who moved eastwards to baronies adjacent to Ormond,' will be launched.

A number of options for day tours during the following week are being explored at present - more details as we get nearer the time. This will be our 9th Annual get together and is of course the highlight of our year with many Kennedys already having their travel plans in place.

Irial Kennedy from Baltimore, Co. Cork had a dream to sail around the world in a yacht. Irial is a cousin of one of our members, Redmond (Reddy) O Regan from Skibbereen, Co. Cork. Reddy, a proud member of I.K.H.G. is descended from Richard Kennedy from Annagh in Lower Ormond, a very illustrious family whose exploits will feature in a future edition of our newsletter.
