(Many Kennedy tombs & the resting place of Tom Crean, explorer.)

12.15 Visit **Garfinny graveyard**, near Lispole(Meet Tom Lynch.)

(Gravestone of Maurice Kennedy, 1816, as cited in "The Dispersal Of Irish Kennedys", p.291)

1.00pm Drive west, via Dingle &around scenic Slea Head

Pause at **Dingle Workhouse** - C19 story of the Kennedys from CillMhica'Domhnaigh, Ventry.

1.40pm Visit IonadAnBhlascaoid /Blasket Centre, DúnChaoin, www. blascaod@opw.ie

Light lunch &two short talks/discussion

- Refreshments& music; Meet local historians & some of the West Kerry Kennedys.


6.00pm Return bus trip from **Dingle - Rear Cross** (2 hours, 40 Mins, 180 kms)

The rugged Dingle Peninsula area (from Annascaul west) has some of the highest densities of Kennedy descendants, outside of the North Tipperary "heartland". The Griffith Valuation, c.1850 recorded 246 Kennedy occupier families on the Peninsula ("Dispersal Of Irish Kennedys", p.292.) This trip will visit some of the places linked with "KerryKennedys".


Taylor Kennedy, Waterdown, Ontario, Canada.

Taylor Kennedy lives in Canada and has amassed a huge amount of research and information on his Kennedy ancestry. His great grandfather Thomas Kennedy was born in Ontario, about 1849 and was son of William Kennedy, born 1806 of Knockadaleen, Terryglass, North Tipperary. Taylor is keen that the knowledge he has gained through his research be made available to the wider Kennedy clan and I am including some of the fruits of his labour in this edition. His work is centred mainly around the civil parishes of Terryglass and Finnoe and will be of particular interest to Kennedys whose ancestors hail from these areas.
