
I have become aware of the sad passing of two members of the I.K.H.G.



Waterford and so is part of the broadly named Comeragh Mountain Kennedys of County Waterford. Last year we connected with the Dingle Peninsula Kennedys so we are really lucky to have David coming to our Gathering to give some insight to the Comeragh Mountain Kennedy branch.

There will also, I believe a reference to a notorious kidnapping **of** (not by, of course) Kennedys in 1779. Intriguing!

We have already received advance notice of people intending to travel from Australia, New Zealand, Canada, U.S.A. and U.K as well as from various parts of Ireland so we look forward to another enjoyable gathering.

The Spread of the Kennedys.

Taylor's great grandfather William Kennedy was born in Terryglass, Co. Tipperary c 1806 and arrived in Ontario, Canada in 1823. Taylor decided to do a census of the descendants of said William-these are his findings.
