

Her brother Andrew b 1834-1903 served in 57th Regiment of Foot campaign in NZ and a constable in Launceston, Tasmania.I believe her father was Andrew Kennedy born circa 1815 Rathkeale/Rathleale?, Limerick and wife Mary nee Hogan b 821County Kilkenny, Ireland.I was wondering if you could forward me some advice as where to start my searching or should I engage a researcher. There seems to be a plenty of Kennedys in County Limerick!!! So far no real luck.



LOOKING BACK 100 YEARS - IRELAND IN DECEMBER 1921

1922: The Partition of the Island



As the truce in the War of Independence continued tense negotiations took place in London throughout November and December between the British and Irish negotiating teams. Then on Dec. 6th 1921 articles of agreement were signed by both parties and the Irish delegation returned to Dublin for ratification of the terms by the Dail, (Irish Parliament). The Irish republicans were deeply divided over the negotiated terms and after much heated debate the terms of the treaty were ratified by Dail Eireann in Jan.1922 by just 7 votes. Eamonn de Valera who opposed the terms of the Treaty resigned as President of Sinn Fein while the pro treaty deputies set about the mammoth task of setting up an independent Irish Free State. Ireland now had its own elected

government to govern the country – albeit 26 counties instead of the hoped for all 32 county island. The saddest episode in the sad history of Ireland was about to unfold but we will hold that until 2022.

NENAGH CASTLE



After 800 years the history of Nenagh is being celebrated this year and naturally the castle that many of you will have visited during your visit to Kennedy territory features centrally in this history. The castle features frequently also in the history of the Irish Kennedys. The O Kennedys seem to have taken occupancy of the castle from the Butlers in the early 1300's but the Butlers didn't go away, so over the following years the two families entered into a number of agreements interspersed by occasional outbreaks of warfare between them. Details of Ormond Deeds relating to matters between the Butlers and the O Kennedys are all listed in 'The Irish Kennedys – The Story of the Rebellious O Kennedys' by Brian Patrick Kennedy.

IRISH KENNEDYS BOOKS


